


# Record steps to reproduce a specific behaviour with PSR (Steps Recorder)

Steps Recorder (before Windows 10 is called Problem Steps Recorder) is a tool available in Windows 10, Windows 8, and Windows 7 that helps you record an issue / behaviour with your computer.


The Steps Recorder will make screenshots of what's on your computer screen and include those in the recording you save

## Step-by-step guide to record a behaviour using PSR

1. Click on the Start button, or open *Run* via WIN+R or the Windows key .
2. Type the "psr" command in the search or run box and then hit the Enter key or press the OK button




3. Steps Recorder should start.



4. Close / Minimize any open windows other than Steps Recorder.
5. Click the Start Record button in Steps Recorder. (the Start Record button changes to aPause Record button and the title bar flashes Recording Now.)
6. Complete the steps necessary to reproduce the behaviour.  
During a recording, you can also press the Add Comment button to highlight a section of your screen and manually add a comment.
7. Click the "Stop Record" button in Steps Recorder to stop recording.

8. Once stopped, the report will appear.



9. Save the report using the "Save" button and a ZIP file containing the report will be created.

**The report generated by PSR can be opened with Internet Explorer or Firefox with "Mozilla Archive Format" add-on.**
